

2012 Site Selection Report

For Sunday Business Meeting, Aussiecon 4

Chicago has been selected to host the 2012 Worldcon. There were 526 votes cast, 506 expressing a preference. With 254 votes needed for a majority Chicago received 447.

There were 25 votes for "none of the above" and 20 expressed no preference. Minneapolis in '73 received 8 votes, Peggy Rae's 4 votes, Monkey's Eyebrow 3, and Dave McCarty's and Xerps in 2010 2 votes each. Fifteen different locations each received a single vote.

There were 189 mail-in ballots and 337 cast at Aussiecon 4.
